- Recognition of Prior Achievement (APA) is a certification method to give recognition to any individual who can demonstrate skills outlined in the National Occupational Skills Standard (NOSS) based on prior experience and achievements.
- Candidates need not go through formal training or sit for an exam. Your skill and knowledge will be assessed according to the competencies in the NOSS.
- All you need to do is to prepare your work portfolio (document) to prove your competency for assessment.
- Malaysian Skills Certificate (Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia – SKM) issued by the Department of Skills Development (Jabatan Pembangunan Kemahiran – JPK) will be awarded once you are assessed and verified by PPT Officer.
- Should you decide to apply for this certification later, the fee for the programme to be paid to JPK is RM 300 per level. But this Talk is free of charge.
