





APEC JAC EE MRA & ACCSQ JSC EEE Meetings

APEC JAC EE MRA Meeting

n 19th and 20th November 2007, a meeting of the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Sub-Committee on Standards and Conformance (SCSC) Joint Advisory Committee (JAC) for Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA) on Conformity Assessment of

Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) was successfully held at Berjaya Times Square Hotel, Kuala Lumpur.

The meeting focused on the need to facilitate trade by reducing technical barriers and to highlight the importance of full commitments by member economies and closer cooperation to move APEC EE MRA forward.

Some important issues were discussed during the meeting, such as member economies to report on significant safety issues involving EEE in their economies; changes on their regulatory regime; status of participation in APEC EE MRA, discussion on the implementation of APEC EE MRA, notification procedure for the designation of test facility and certification body and New Zealand's risk assessment calculation system.

ACCSQ JSC EEE Meeting

The 4th Meeting of the Asean Consultative Committee for Standards & Quality (ACCSQ) Joint Sectoral Committee for Electrical and Electronic Equipment (JSC EEE) was held from 21st to 22nd November 2007 at the same venue.

The Meeting was attended by representatives from Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam and the ASEAN Secretariat. 


