

## 12th APEC JAC Meeting

he 12th meeting of the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation Sub-Committee on Standards and Conformance Joint Advisory Committee (JAC) was held in the morning of 14th May 2008 at the Empire Hotel & Country Club, Brunei Darussalam. The meeting reviewed measures in the APEC EEMRA (Electrical and



# Trade Visit to Guangzhou Lighting Fair 2008

he Guangzhou International Lighting Exhibition was held on 8th to 11th June 2008 at Guangzhou International Convention & Exhibition Centre, Guangzhou, China. The show featured a complete range of technical & exterior lighting, domestic lighting, professional lights, electric lights, accessories and components. A special LED (Light Emitting Diodes) hall was highlighted for the first time in 2008. TEEAM was invited as a supporting organisation.

With energy-savings and environmental-friendliness at the forefront of China's agenda, the LED market is growing fast, achieving a growth rate of 18% in 2005. With their low energy consumption, longer life-spans and a vast array of applications, LEDs are gaining popularity.

A 9-member delegation from TEEAM led by Past President, Mr Suresh Gorasia visited this annual exhibition. 1,539 exhibitors from 21 countries spread across a record-breaking 10 halls. A total of 48,105 visitors from 96 countries visited the exhibition. Exhibitor numbers rose 25 per cent compared to last year. Overseas visitors numbered 10,243, an increase of 3% from 2007 and domestic visitors increased by 8% to 37,862.

Running alongside the fair was Electrical Building Technology Guangzhou, an

A Lighting Technology Symposium held during the fair once again proved to be popular with visitors. This year's theme was "Master planning, design, implementation and management of urban lighting." Around 1,250 people attended a total of 11 seminars which covered the topics of LED technology, cost management of lighting, master planning and management of urban lighting, landscape lighting and architecture & interior lighting. The symposium was co-organised with Guangzhou Yang Guang Lighting Service Co, Ltd, and supported by the China Illuminating Engineering Society.

The next Guangzhou International Lighting Fair is scheduled for 8th to 11th June 2009.

# Trade Visit to Guangzhou Lighting Fair 2008

he Guangzhou International Lighting Exhibition was held on 8th to 11th June 2008 at Guangzhou International Convention & Exhibition Centre, Guangzhou, China. The show featured a complete range of technical & exterior lighting, domestic lighting, professional lights, electric lights, accessories and components.
