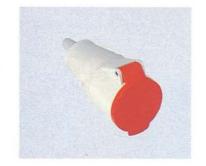










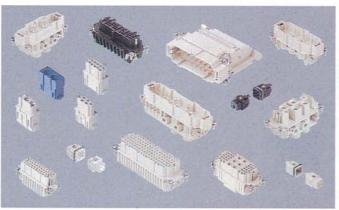

# **TEEAM 56th Anniversary Dinner**

n 23rd August 2008, TEEAM celebrated its 56th anniversary at One World Hotel, Petaling Jaya. Some 1,070 guests and members attended the dinner celebration. Dato' Sri Prof Ir Dr Judin Abdul Karim, Director General of Public Works Malaysia graced the occasion as the Guest of Honour.

The dinner theme, "Towards Green Energy" was chosen to remind everyone that global warming due to climatic change as a result of emission of excessive fossil carbon is reaching an alarming state. TEEAM President, Dato' Ir Lee Peng Joo highlighted that cutting waste, reduce energy losses and going for higher energy efficiency is one of the practical and least expensive solutions to meet growing energy demand. In view of rising energy cost and the need for sustainable energy in the future, going for renewable energy like solar, biomass, capture landfill gases, converting municipal waste and hydro power into green energy must be given priority and the government must give strong support.

Malaysia may consider nuclear energy as it is a cheaper energy cost per kwh compared to coal and gas fuel. It is more environmentally friendly as it emits less green house gas and modern technology now makes it very safe to operate.

Dato' Lee went on to urge the Ministry of Works to urgently implement the proposed Payment Adjudication Act to help the construction industry to resolve the long outstanding payment issue. Countries like Australia, New Zealand, United Kingdom and Singapore have implemented such law many years ago and Malaysia is slow in this aspect. The recent announcement of direct payment to suppliers and subcontractors by the Honourable Prime Minister and Minister of

Finance showed how serious payment problem is in the construction industry.

Dato' Sri Prof Ir Dr Judin Abdul Karim highlighted in his keynote address that steps are being taken to ensure a more sustainable source of energy for the future. The need to conserve and improve efficiency in the usage of electricity is becoming prominent. Recycling is a way to conserve the environment and energy efficient buildings can reduce the requirement in electricity generation and carbon emission.

As to the Payment Adjudication Act, the government through CIDB has introduced it to help to protect the interests of all parties. The escalation of material prices is another issue highlighted at the dinner. TEEAM is working closely with CIDB on the building material price index. Dato' Sri Prof Ir Dr Judin expressed that the government will be the first to apply the price escalation mechanism so that contractors can complete their projects in a timely manner. To ease the burden of contractors affected by the rising cost of building materials, the government has agreed to include fourteen key construction materials for variation of price (VOP). For mechanical and electrical works, VOP will be backdated to 1st January 2008.




and cable accessories technology and cable jointing techniques practiced in Malaysia.


