

From The Editor's Desk



s we usher in the year of 2013 we are faced with great anticipation on the coming General Election. The political landscape has altered somewhat and it is no longer possible for anyone to predict the outcome of the Election. Therefore the business sentiment is also greatly affected. We shall hope for a fair and safe General Election so that we can be proud of the maturity of the electorate.

The Malaysian economy grew at 5.6% for the whole of 2012 and 6.4% in Q4. Total Private Sector investment has been a main driver of growth. The forecast for 2013 is 4.5 to 5.5 %.

Suruhanjaya Tenaga is revising the Guide for Electrical Wiring 2008. The Wiring Guide has provided good application of RCDs in distribution boards. RCDs provide good and sensitive protection against any leakages of current. However it has been the cause of many unnecessary outages due to nuisance trippings. Correct and appropriate application of RCDs is therefore urgently required to improve the safe distribution of electricity.

TEEAM is embarking on a project to collect and dispose of used CFLs. The disposal of used CFLs currently is not managed properly. In order to prevent the risk of exposure to mercury, it is necessary to collect back used CFLs for recycling.

We wish to congratulate ASEAN ELENEX 2013 for another good show and we wish them every success in their 10th International Exhibition of Transmission & Distribution and Electrical Engineering for ASEAN.



TEEAM 62nd ISSUE

Meeting with Suruhanjaya Tenaga

EEAM held a meeting with Suruhanjaya Tenaga (ST) on 8th November 2012 at ST Building, Putrajaya. Vice Presidents, Mr Yap Ching Kiat & Mr David Chong led the TEEAM delegation, comprising Mr Ho Khai Hong (Honorary Secretary), Mr C T Siew (Council Member), Ir Yong Ah Huat (Council Member) and Mr Tan Eng Liang (Council Member). On hand to receive TEEAM were Datuk Ir Ahmad Fauzi Hasan (CEO of Suruhanjaya Tenaga) and his senior officers. The objective of the meeting was to put forward TEEAM's concern on the following issues:

Market Surveillance on Regulated Products

In the context of the ASEAN MRA and APEC MRA on E & E Equipment (EEE) – Market Surveillance is "the way to go" in a liberalised market. TEEAM intends to play an active role in assisting ST to carry out market surveillance to ensure that:

- (i) the E&E products purchased have successfully passed the appropriate tests with SIRIM stickers attached on the products and,
- (ii) whether the products are compliant with the requirements of the relevant IEC Standards for the sake of public safety.

TEEAM appealed to ST to appoint TEEAM as a Designated Body to carry out Market Surveillance on some or all the 31 categories of controlled items. ST highlighted that there is no provision in the Act for private entity to be appointed as designated body to carry out surveillance/enforcement. However, ST welcomes TEEAM to provide information to the Commission on non-compliant products. ST has assigned SIRIM to collect products from the market to carry out tests to ensure products are compliant.

TEEAM also highlighted the issue of substandard wiring cables widely marketed and used, and products which carry fake SIRIM stickers. In response, ST requested TEEAM to notify the Commission if TEEAM should come across any non-compliant activities pertaining to electrical safety as ST is looking for new ways to improve their effectiveness. ST has approached MCMA to ensure their members produce compliant cables. TEEAM also appealed to ST to publicise the list of cases prosecuted so as to alert the public.

LED Products Added to the List of Controlled Items

TEEAM sought ST's clarification on the LED products which were added to the lamp fittings category of the list of controlled items

which take effect from 1st January 2013. TEEAM also requested for customs tariff codes for LED products in order for members to prepare well in advance for customs clearance and the tariff involved.

notified that the LED domestic lighting and compact fluorescent lamp (CFL) are fitted with built-in self-ballast. Hence, to comply with the safety standards performance and requirements, STis controlling such items.

With regards to the customs tariff

code, TEEAM requested ST to provide the specific custom codes for the new products. Tariff code is provided by customs to classify commodities when they are being declared at the customs frontiers by exporters and importers. ST advised the manufacturers to apply for certificate of approval from ST soonest possible before the enforcement, as obtaining the test report and CB certificate from recognised testing bodies takes a very long time. TEEAM highlighted that these tests require 2000 – 6000 hrs. Hence, TEEAM appealed for grace period to enable members to prepare themselves.

ST's Competency Exam and TEEAM as an Accredited Training Institution

ST no longer conducts competency exams for Wiremen and Chargemen AO & A1 effective from July 2012. Instead, candidates have to sit for the exam at ST's accredited training institutions. In this case, TEEAM sought ST's approval to designate TEEAM as an accredited training institution to conduct wiremen and chargemen competency exams. TEEAM is able to conduct such exams because TEEAM has been running wiremen training courses since the 80s and also conducting CIDB building wiring installer course.

TEEAM would like to take the initiative to create more wiremen and chargemen to meet the industry's demand. However, ST informed that TEEAM has to collaborate with accredited

g o v e r n m e n t institution or government link institution to be recognised by ST as an accredited training and exam centre.

Conclusion



The discussion was fruitful

and TEEAM thanked ST for the time and opportunity given to delve on issues of concern.

ST has on 14th December 2012 announced the deferral of enforcement for the new list of electrical equipment Lampiran A that requires certificate of approval from ST. The enforcement date is deferred from 1st January 2013 to 1st July 2013 for equipment to obtain approval, and market enforcement will begin on 1st January 2014

The reason for the deferral is test report and CB certificate from recognised testing bodies requires test to be conducted for a duration of 3 – 6 months period. Members can obtain the ST's notification and new list of equipment from the TEEAM Secretariat.

Meanwhile Certificate of Approval can be applied online. Visitwww.st.gov.my→ePermit→subscription →register online to be a Dagang Net subscriber to access the ePermit system. You will receive your login ID upon successful registration within two working days. ePermit is provided by Dagang Net to facilitate online application & approval of permits

exercise in preparing them for the coming implementation of the Energy Efficiency & Conservation Law (EE & C Law) expected to come into force by end 2013 or early 2014. This will enable them to be energy efficient in their operation, reduce operation cost, and help government in achieving the target of EE goals and cut global warming/reduce Malaysia's carbon emission;

- Propose the government to reduce personal and corporate tax to 23%. Our Thailand counterpart trade association informed that Thailand will be reducing their corporate tax to 23% in their coming Budget. Singapore corporate tax is currently at 17% and Hong Kong 15%;
- Propose the government not to wait for the implementation of GST before the reduction of corporate tax. Malaysia's competitiveness is fast deteriorating if Thailand reduces their corporate tax ahead of Malaysia. Malaysia might fast lose out in both FDI as well as LDI;
- To further boost domestic consumption and help private SMEs to innovate and to move up the value chain, the

government could play an important role by introducing policies such as 'Buy Malaysia 1st' or buy quality products by quality specification instead of naming company in their purchasing policy. TEEAM hopes KeTTHA will support the effort of TEEAM in requesting MOF to abolish the MOF lighting circular PKP 7/2010 which specifies that all purchasing must be supplied through the companies named in the circular; and

• Propose the government to allocate some funding to help Trade NGOs such as



- Propose the government to reduce personal and corporate tax to 23%. Our Thailand counterpart trade association informed that Thailand will be reducing their corporate tax to 23% in their coming Budget. Singapore corporate tax is currently at 17% and Hong Kong 15%;
- Proposethegovernment not to wait for the implementation before GST the reduction of corporate Malaysia's competitiveness fast deteriorating if Thailand reduces their corporate tax ahead of Malaysia. Malaysia might fast lose out in both FDI as well as LDI;
- To further boost domestic consumption and help private SMEs to innovate and to move up the value chain, the

government could play an important role by introducing policies such as 'Buy Malaysia 1st' or buy quality products by quality specification instead of naming company in their purchasing policy. TEEAM hopes KeTTHA will support the effort of TEEAM in requesting MOF to abolish the MOF lighting circular PKP 7/2010 which specifies that all purchasing must be supplied through the companies named in the circular; and

14th Meeting of JSC EEE

he Fourteenth Meeting of the Joint Sectoral Committee for Electrical and Electronic Equipment (JSC EEE) was held on 20th to 22nd November 2012 in Yogyakarta, Indonesia. The meeting was chaired by Mr Steven Tan, Group Director of Quality and Standards, SPRING, Singapore and co-chaired by Mr Sathaporn Rungrattanaubol, Senior Standards Officer, Standards Bureau 2, Thai Industrial Standards Institute (TISI), Thailand.

The meeting was attended by representatives from Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Viet Nam, representatives from ACCSQ WG 1, the ASEAN Secretariat and representatives from International Electrotechnical Commission Pacific Regional Center (IEC-APRC). The representatives of Key Expert on Standards for the ASEAN Regional Integration Support Programme from EU (ARISE) and delegations from Japan Ministry of Trade and Industry and Business Machine Industry Association (JBMIA) were also in attendance. There were a total of 63 delegates of whom eight were from Malaysia represented by ST, SIRIM QAS and TEEAM.

The meeting was officiated by the HE Bayu Krisnamurthi, Vice Minister of Trade, Republic of Indonesia. He extended his warm welcome to all the delegates of the 14th JSC EEE Meeting to the culture-rich city of Yogyakarta. HE Bayu Krisnamurthi shared the following in his remarks for the JSC EEE Meeting to consider:

- To meet the integration timeline by 2015 noting that ASEAN leaders had agreed to announce the Economic Integration of ASEAN by 31st December 2015. ASEAN is a stable region economically with a large market of 600 million consumers.
- To be mindful of the challenges and differences of Member States in achieving the economic integration of the EEE sector noting that AMS has become more conscious of the ASEAN economic integration and could introduce measures to make sure that their local industries and the consumers are equally protected.
- To take into considerations the technological developments of the products as EEE becomes more advanced in terms of features where it could function as an ICT equipment.
- To take into consideration external parties who are engaging with ASEAN. ASEAN, as a region, has to be mindful of its dialogue partners as key players in the integration initiative. JSC EEE has to take this into consideration in the deliberations and in making decisions.

The meeting witnessed the handover of Chairmanship by Philippines to Singapore, and Co-Chairmanship by Singapore to Thailand. The outgoing Chair expressed his appreciation to the JSC EEE members for the supports extended to him during his term as the JSC EEE Chair.

The meeting went on to discuss the following, among others:

- · ASEAN integration initiatives.
- Implementation of measures for the EEE sector in the AEC scorecard.
- Harmonisation of standards & listing of CAB under ASEAN EEMRA.
- Technical regulations to enhance transparency.
- ASEAN harmonised EEE regulatory regime
- Cooperation with international organisations and dialogue partners.

The delegates expressed their appreciation to the Ministry of Trade, Republic of Indonesia for the warm hospitality and excellent arrangements made for the meeting. The meeting also thanked the ASEAN Secretariat for the assistance provided. Held in the traditional spirit of ASEAN cordiality and solidarity, everyone had a wonderful and memorable stay in Yogyakarta.



The discussion was fruitful with interesting market information being exchanged. The KECA guests thanked TEEAM for the time and opportunity given.






