Courtesy Visit to the KeTTHA Minister

n 18th June 2013, TEEAM paid a courtesy visit to Yang Berhormat Datuk Seri Panglima Dr Maximus Johnity Ongkili, Minister of Energy, Green Technology and Water (KeTTHA). The issue of concern raised to the Minister was about the implementation of Certificate of Approval (COA) for electrical equipment for each product model effective 1st July 2013 which was announced by Suruhanjaya Tenaga (ST).

So far, TEEAM has received strong objection from the members and other associations. TEEAM highlighted that the new ruling will increase the cost of business tremendously.

Currently, one COA can cover many product models of the same range but after 1st July 2013, ST requires one COA for one model. TEEAM highlighted few cases of cost implication, with one showing that the cost will increase by 52 times! This cost will eventually be passed on to the consumers

Following the above meeting, ST has issued a circular to notify that the implementation of one COA for one product model effective 1st July 2013 will be deferred. We look forward to favourable options on this COA matter in the near future.

On to the LED lighting products which have been included into the ST controlled items and COA's original effective date of 1st July 2013, TEEAM has requested for deferment to 1st January 2014. There is delay in the testing of these products

as they require long hours of testing and there is now a long queue for the said testing.

Subsequently, the ST Director of Safety informed that the enforcement date by the Customs will only take effect from 1st January 2014. However, ST encourages suppliers to obtain the required COA before 1st January 2014.

It was a fruitful meeting and TEEAM thanked the Minister for his time and attention.

CFL Recycling Project

TEEAM is currently embarking on an energy saving compact fluorescent lamp (CFL) Recycling Program under the GEF/SGP (Global Environment Facility/Small Grants Programme) to educate the public on proper disposal of used CFLs. This project is in line with the national green initiatives. The theme of the project is "Together We Make a Difference". Energy saving CFL has been popular among consumers due to its high light efficiency, low power consumption and relatively long service life. However, the use of mercury in the production of the lamps and the unavailability of recycling facilities, CFLs are polluting our soil, water and environment. Most people are uninformed and treat the CFLs as regular incandescent lamps, therefore they discard the lamp as common waste.

This project has created a convenient way for CFL users to dispose their used CFLs for recycling and thereby help protect the environment. TEEAM has identified suitable trader outlets and shopping malls to place the collection bins for the public to drop their used CFLs. The detailed list with address of collection points for used CFLs is in the TEEAM website www.teeam.org.my. TEEAM has engaged a recycling contractor, Kualiti Alam to collect the used CFLs lamps from the collection points for proper disposal. The project was planned from January 2013 and will last until December 2013. A special SGP Working Group headed by Ir Chin Kuan Hwa was formed to plan and carry out the activities. Other WG members are Ir Chew Shee Fuee, Ir Chang Yew Cheong, Mr Tan Eng Liang, Mr Ong Ah Cheong, Mr How Chee Seng and Mr Chong Yoon Koon.

A soft launch was held at Setia City Mall on 1st June 2013. The campaign received good response from the public and at the same time created awareness among the young and senior citizens. TV 2 Mandarin Desk has done a coverage on the CFL project and it was broadcasted on TV2 from 10th to 14th June 2013 at 12.20 pm for public awareness. The project was also published in The China Press, Sin Chew Daily and Utusan Malaysia to attract public attention. TEEAM will continue to raise awareness among the public on proper disposal of used CFLs which contain harmful mercury content and to make the right decision to dispose used lamps in a proper manner instead of disposing them as common waste.







Ecotrafo is producing the most cost effective and advanced 3-D wound-core transformers. It has a smaller space requirement as compared to conventional type. Silicon steel is used and with 3-D core structure, usage is almost 100% with minimal wastage. There is also less iron loss due to its 3-D core design. The wound core technology reduces vibration as there is no gap between the lamination due to its continuous one sheet of silicon steel and joints are not required. Hence noise level can be reduced to 45dB. It was an interesting trip.

meeting was held with the Exporters Development Division of Malaysia External Trade Development Corporation (MATRADE) on 12th July 2013 at Menara MATRADE. Eligible expenses are paid through a reimbursable grant which is subject to a maximum limit of RM 100,000 per company per year and a cumulative maximum grant of RM 300,000 per company throughout the 10th Malaysia Plan (2011-2015).

Some of the eligible activities are participation in international exhibition held locally or overseas; trade & investment missions; specialised marketing mission; participation in international conference overseas to promote products or services; etc. For application and claim procedures, members can refer to MATRADE MDG Guidelines which can be downloaded from MATRADE website www.matrade.gov.my.


