Press Conference on Water Heater Electrocution

he latest electrocution incident involving electric water heater is tragic and serves as a serious warning to all of us. In that mishap a Japanese couple were electrocuted and found dead in the bathroom of their apartment.

In the aftermath, TEEAM is taking initiative to provide some safety guidelines and advices so that the public can take immediate action to improve protection in the event of any failure of wiring and water heater. A press conference was organised on 12th September 2013 at TEEAM to reach out to the public.

All water heaters are equipped with heating coils. This is an electrically powered coil which is immersed in the water inside the water heater. Any insulation failure of this coil will endanger the person using the water heater.

To isolate (switch off) the electrical supply in the event of a failure, protection can be provided by an external 10mA RCCB (residual current circuit breaker). It is a device that can detect and measure current leakage. It will immediately trip and isolate the circuit should the leakage current exceed its

tripping value and this case should be 10mA (0.01Amp). The recommended RCCB rating for rated current of 25amp is rated residual tripping current (sensitivity) of 10mA.

Once installed, RCCBs must be regularly tested at least four times a year. This tripping test can easily be done by pressing a dedicated button marked "TEST" on the RCCB. The RCCB should be replaced if it fails to trip. All house owners must engage a qualified and registered electrical contractor to install water heaters.

They met TNB Vice President (Distribution) Datuk Ir Baharin Din, Ir Kamaliah Abdul Kadir (Senior General Manager of Customer Service) and other TNB Officials, including Mr Mohd Adibi, Mr Shahabudin Zakaria, Ir Mahathir Nor Ismail, Ms Rose Salinawati Sallehuddin and Mr Sansubari Che Mud

Among the issues discussed were:

Outdoor Feeder Pillar & Metering Panel

TEEAM highlighted a case where a metering panel manufactured according to drawing and installed at site was rejected by TNB.

TNB responded that material and product specification are among other elements to be looked into. The Customer Service Department of TNB will follow up on the matter and it was agreed to form a task force consisting of both TEEAM and TNB representatives to resolve issues promptly.

Safety of 2-Pin Plugs in 3-Pin Socket Outlets

Two-pin plugs are not safe to be used in three-pin socket outlets. It is dangerous to poke metal objects into the main plug hole to plug in the two-pin plugs as it can cause electrocution. TEEAM's stand is that there should be a Law to replace 2-pin plug with a standard 3-pin plug.

TNB agreed that the safety of consumers cannot be compromised. However the matter needs to be referred to the Regulator which is the Energy Commission.

15A Inferior Plug Top

There are many inferior 15A plug tops in the market. These items are unsafe to be

used as they could not carry the current load and hence can easily catch fire. TEEAM believes that TNB can effectively reach out to the consumers.

TNB agreed on the safety principle but requested TEEAM to highlight the issue to the Energy Commission.

Power Factor Incentive

TEEAM is promoting power factor incentive. If every consumer can achieve at least 0.95 power factor, then TNB has another 10% of electricity for sale, without incurring any additional investment cost. TEEAM hoped that TNB is receptive to this win-win idea to offer some incentives in the form of discounts to the consumers' bills. This proposal had been brought up to TNB before. It was highlighted that manufacturers are already producing standard off-the-shelf automatic power factor correction capacitor panels for LV commercial tariff applications. TEEAM hoped that the proposal on the reimbursement to consumers who achieve power factor >0.85 can be considered.

TNB informed that the utility has brought up the issue to the Energy Commission. TNB is of the opinion that any incentive for power factor must be coupled to tariff structure and on the basis of overall industry scenario.

TNB Meter Suppliers

In view of the many cases of meter dispute, TEEAM requested for a list of TNB meter suppliers.

TNB highlighted that meters procurement is on a tendering basis and the list of meter suppliers is available on the net.

Buy Malaysian Products

TEEAM requested TNB to use Malaysian products in its system to support the local industry. The meeting was informed that it is TNB's policy to buy local products if they are available locally. TNB highlighted that more than 90% of TNB Distribution products are locally made.

Joint CSR Activities

Both TNB and TEEAM agreed to join force for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities. TEEAM highlighted that the association is working on a campaign on self-test RCCBs and invites TNB to support and participate in the campaign.

Conclusion

It was a fruitful dialogue and TEEAM looks forward to continue the close working relationship with TNB Distribution.



16th Meeting of JSC EEE

he Energy Commission of Malaysia hosted the sixteenth Meeting of the Joint Sectoral Committee for Electrical and Electronic Equipment (JSC EEE) held from 19th to 21st November 2013 at Park Royal Hotel, Kuala Lumpur. The meeting was preceded by the JISC/IEC/APSG Human Resource Development Seminar on "Standard for Green Society" held a day earlier.

The meeting was attended by representatives from the ASEAN member states including Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Viet Nam. Representatives from the ASEAN Secretariat; International Electrotechnical Commission - Asia Pacific Regional Center (IEC-APRC); ASEAN Regional Integration Support Programme by EU (ARISE); International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC); Ministry of Economy, Trade & Industry, Japan; Physikalischi-Technische Bundesanstalt (PTB), Germany and Lites Asia were also in attendance. Representatives from TEEAM, Ir Chew Shee Fuee KMN (President) and Ir Rocky H T Wong (Honorary Fellow & Technical Adviser) were members of the Malaysian delegation headed by the Energy Commission (Suruhanjaya Tenaga - ST).





CFL Recycling Project

TEEAM has implemented successful programme for recycling CFLs (Compact Fluorescent Lamps) under the GEF/SGP (Global Environment Facility/Small Grants Programme) directive. TEEAM has taken the initiative to dispose the used bulbs in a responsible way - a small step but a significant leap in ensuring a better environment for the future. TEEAM has encouraged members, stakeholders, retailers and the public to practise proper disposal of used CFL bulbs because they contain mercury that is toxic and poses an environmental and safety hazard when disposed in normal landfills. Most people are uninformed and treat the CFLs as regular incandescent lamps and dispose them as common waste.

This CFL recycling programme officially started in December 2012 and ended in January 2014. Collection bins and informative buntings were placed at designated points to collect used CFLs. TEEAM had reached out to government agencies, hotels, hospitals, shopping malls, LRT stations, dealer's shops and residence to encourage participation in this green effort.

This programme has been successful in educating the public, retailers, stakeholders, workers, commuters and TEEAM members on proper disposal of used CFLs. Overall, the impact and turnout were encouraging. A total of 36 collection points were set up for the purpose. TEEAM successfully collected some 10,000 pcs of used CFLs. Kualiti Alam was engaged to collect the used CFLs from the drop-off collection points for proper and safe disposal. TEEAM wishes to put in record special words of thanks and appreciation to the collection points for their great efforts and cooperation.

Efforts are underway to seek further funding from GEF/SGP to continue this green effort. TEEAM hopes to extend this recycling programme to the collection of fluorescent lamps (FLs). TEEAM will continue to promote awareness among the public on

proper disposal of used CFLs and FLs which contain harmful mercury content and help them to make the right decision to dispose these used lamps in a proper manner instead of disposing them as common household waste.




