












CIE 2014 Conference

IE 2014 International Conference on Lighting Quality & Energy Efficiency was successfully held from 23rd to 26th April 2014 at Hotel Istana, Kuala Lumpur. It was jointly organised by CIE and Malaysia CIE (MyCIE) and hosted by Standards Malaysia under the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI). Local Organising Committee Chairman, Mr Narendren Rengasamy delivered the welcome address, which was followed by the opening address by CIE President, Prof Ann Webb. YB Datuk Dr Abu Bakar Mohamad Diah, Deputy Minister of MOSTI who represented the Minister of Science, Technology & Innovation, YB Datuk Dr Ewon Ebin, officiated the conference by hitting the gong. The conference opened with the first keynote address entitled "Promoting Efficient Use of Electrical Energy - Malaysia's Experience", presented by YBhg Datuk Ir Ahmad Fauzi Hasan, Chairman of Malaysia Electrotechnical National Committee.

Several top lighting experts were invited to speak at the conference including Mr George C Brainard, Mr Tran Quoc Khanh, Mr Thorsten Vehoff, Mr Martine Knoop, Mr Janos Schanda and Mr David H. Sliney. CIE 2014 recorded the highest volumes of abstract submission compared to previous conferences. A total of six keynote speeches, 66 oral presentations and 87 poster papers from all over the world presented the latest research results and survey lectures on various subjects related to light and lighting. The focus of the conference included the followings:

- Daylight, Lighting Systems and Energy Saving
- · Light and the Visual Perception of Quality
- Photobiological Effects
- Characterising lighting systems

The 3-day event provided a conducive learning and sharing platform for lighting experts. It also offered an invaluable opportunity for intensified exchange and technical interaction among the lighting experts on the development of lighting in Malaysia and ASEAN as well as to discover the latest developments of energy efficient lighting technologies and standards. This conference also provided a unique opportunity for the worldwide community of engineers, scientists and designers from the lighting industry, research organisations and academia to meet, present and discuss their works on light sources and lighting.

Like the previous editions, the conference served as a vital forum for all the experts and interested people involved in new challenges and recent breakthroughs in this field. The presentation of the topics, the discussion and exchange of ideas in this conference would act as catalysts and trigger the generation of new and innovative solutions for on-going problems. The event highlighted new directions in lighting for commercial and public applications, both locally and globally, and seeks to elevate public awareness on the importance of lighting quality.

Six workshops were organised in conjunction with the conference to provide a forum for information exchange and updates on this rapidly evolving technology. Each workshop recorded an overwhelming number of participants with an average of over 40 participants per session. The workshops covered different research topics namely on Measurement of OLEDs; Optical Radiation can be Good for People; Standardisation and



Self-Test RCCB National Campaign

EEAM has initiated a national campaign on self-test Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB) at home. Electrical appliances have the inherent risk of electricity leakage either due to wear & tear, malfunction, and/or improper installation.

RCCB is the safety device that prevents electrocution by cutting off electricity supply immediately upon detecting any leakage in an electrical circuit. Faulty or defective RCCB in the distribution board has been identified as among the causes of electrocution involving water heaters at homes in the country. A survey conducted by Energy Commission of Malaysia (ST) in 2013 showed that a majority 64% of the respondents were unsure of how to test the RCCB.

Themed 'Be Safe, Self-Test Your RCCB Today!', TEEAM's safety campaign aims to raise awareness among the public on the need for regular self-testing of RCCBs. The official launch was held on 10th June 2014 by YBhg Datuk Ir Ahmad Fauzi Hasan, Chief Executive Officer of Energy Commission. The target of this safety campaign is to have one million homes in Malaysia self-tested their RCCB by May 2015.

TEEAM is conducting roadshowsatshopping malls and exhibitions to educate the public on how to test their home RCCB through demonstration Roadshows units. were conducted in Tropicana City Mall on 19th & 20th 2014, Home Mall on 17th August 2014 and 1 U Shopping Centre on 6th & 7th September Upcoming

CFL & FL Recycling Programme

TEEAM is carrying out its second phase of Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL) Recycling Programme as part of its continuous commitment towards environment protection and sustainability. The programme is approved under the GEF/SGP (Global Environment Facility/Small Grants Programme) directive. The second phase will include the collection of used Fluorescent Lamps (FL) which are widely used in homes and offices. TEEAM hopes that the second phase of CFL & FL Recycling Programme would give important momentum in achieving the following objectives:

- To reduce the environmental risk from improper disposal of CFL & FL to landfill;
- To educate and encourage the public to practice recycling in their daily life;
- To provide an avenue for everyone to make a difference; and
- To protect the environment for human and eco-system health.

Disposal of used CFLs and FLs in landfills is among the primary sources of mercury pollution that could migrate to groundwater and also become airborne. Though the Malaysian government is determined to provide sustainable recycling system in the country but CFL & FL recycling is not a national legal requirement. Therefore, TEEAM would like to influence the government to establish basic policies and conduct public relations for promoting CFL & FL recycling. TEEAM hopes to educate the community to make the right decisions about how and where to dispose of their used CFL & FL.
