#### EW, CFL & FL Recycling Programme

his programme has been a joint-collaborative effort of the Malaysia International Commission of Illumination (MyCIE) and TEEAM, to create awareness and good habits for the general public and targeted groups on the proper disposal of e-waste (EW), compact fluorescent lamps (CFL) and fluorescent lamps (FL).

From the very onset, this public-oriented programme received a great deal of attention from various Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) and Residents' Associations located in the Klang Valley. MyCIE/TEEAM is running this important programme under industrial sponsorship with the noble intent that it will lead to a sustained recycling system in Malaysia. A number of publicity activities were conducted at various Schools, Shopping Malls, Offices, Residential Areas and Universities to create the much-needed awareness

On 4th and 5th June 2016, a two-day roadshow was held at the AEON Ipoh Station 18 Shopping Centre to raise awareness among the shoppers. The roadshow received good response from the public and at the same time created awareness among the shoppers. It has also been studied and confirmed that if water is travelling through a 1.0 metre (3.3 feet) long pathway and in a 10 mm inner diameter hose, the electric current will not kill a person even if the person is standing barefoot on a wet floor. Therefore, when a user touches the stainless steel hose, it is still safe.

c) Refer to the picture without isolation barrier, the 14A is the load current of water heater = 3300/240 = 13.75 approx. = 14A. The maximum leakage current should reach 240V/500 Ohm (average body resistance under wet conditions) = 0.48 Amp. (Assume a total short). The key fact in electrical shock is that, any shock current is more than 0.01 Amp (10 mili Amp) can kill a person.







