



TEEAM 74th ISSUE

Technical Visit to the MRT Info Centre

n 14th May 2018, TEEAM successfully organised a Technical Visit to the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) Info Centre located at Bandar Malaysia North, Kuala Lumpur. The visit received a good response from 22 TEEAM Council Members as well as the Committee Members and Secretariat Staffs. Upon arriving, the delegation was well received by officials from MMC Gamuda KVMRT(T) Sdn Bhd. An enlightening presentation was conducted by Mr Leong Shen-Li of the Strategic Communications & Stakeholders Relations of MRT Corporation.

The Klang Valley Mass Rapid Transit (KVMRT) project is part of the Government's Economic Transformation Programme (ETP) owned by the Malaysian Government through the MRT Corporation. MMC Gamuda undertakes the design and construction work for the underground package of the KVMRT project while MRT Corporation is the developer and asset owner of this KVMRT project. The first SBK MRT Line (Line 1) stretches from Sungai Buloh to Kajang covering a total distance of 51km and hosts 31 stations. It serves a catchment area of 1.2 million residents in the Klang Valley. Completed on 17th July 2017, the SBK Line hopes to reach a daily ridership of over 400,000 and now helps to mitigate the infamous traffic snarls.

The MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya Line (SSP Line) is the second MRT Line (Line 2) started to develop under the KVMRT project and construction is now underway. The line has a 52.2km alignment of which 38.7km is elevated and 13.5km is underground. The mega infrastructure project involves the design, construction

and completion of tunnels, underground stations and associated structures such as portals including escape shafts for the SSP Line underground. This SSP Line is expected to commence full service in the second quarter of 2022. This will further improve the traffic congestion problems faced by Kuala Lumpur, with an expected ridership of 530,000 passengers per day.

A third line called the MRT Circle Line will run some 40km long with 26 stations located in the Klang Valley. The expected completion date is in July 2026.

Overall, it was a very interesting visit for all who were present in getting unsurpassed first-hand information on the MRT1, MRT2 and the MRT3 Lines. It has also created an excellent avenue for win-

win networking and the exploring of business opportunities vis these multi-billion dollar mega projects. A big thank you and great appreciation go to MMC-Gamuda KVMRT for cordially hosting the visit and also MRT Corporation for the exciting enlightening sessions. Congratulations!



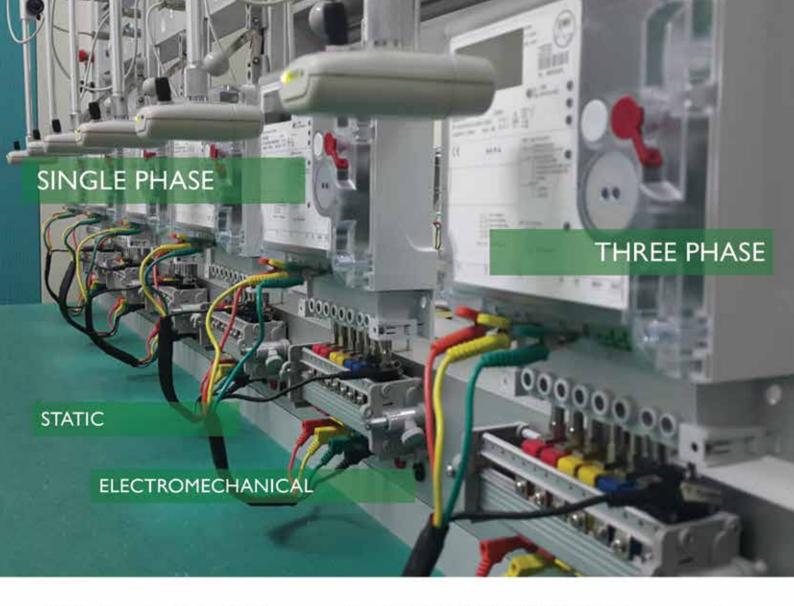


Visit to UCTS

Council Meeting


